

Volunteer-led: As a church-based ministry, all the programs and services are run and managed by church volunteers to ensure a sense of community





Vocational: all the programs are delivered by a pool of volunteers who offer their professional services (ESL Teachers, Career Mentors, Dentists, Medical Doctors, Psychotherapists, etc.)

Holistic: The provision of support to refugees include emergency housing through the Silas Hill Refugee Shelter to English Language Instruction, Employment Support, Medical/Dental/mental health support, and settlement/immigration services

Strategic Partnership: the delivery of programs and services is enhanced and complemented through collaboration with city and non-profit organizations
